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## Junior Code of Conduct

If you do not follow this Code of Conduct, the Club may have to take disciplinary action.

As a member of **Arkley Golf Club** you are expected to follow the Code of Conduct:-

- Play according to the 'Rules of Golf' and in the 'Spirit of the Game'. The Spirit of the Game can be found on the inside cover of the Rule Book as well as on the R & A website <http://www.randa.org/>
- Respect all players – male and female, all ages, all abilities, all religions and all cultures
- Respect the ideas, efforts and enthusiasm of the coaches, volunteers and other golfers
- Do not laugh at fellow golfers, harass or bully them or prevent them from playing
- Do not lose your temper. Never hit or kick equipment or facilities or shout or swear - before, during or after a game or training session
- Dangerous play will not be tolerated. It will lead to a player being told to leave the course
- Do not smoke, drink alcohol or take drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club in competitions, home or away
- Do not make critical or disrespectful comments about others including posting hurtful comments on social media sites
- Have a positive attitude and encourage others to be positive
- Train and play to the best of your ability
- Respect the facilities at Arkley Golf Club and other clubs
- Make sure that your parents or guardians know where you are whilst you are at the golf club
- Be on time and prepared for events, matches and training sessions
- Wear suitable, clean clothing according to the AGC dress code for all events, matches and training as agreed with the coach or team manager
- Pay any fees for training or events promptly.
